Pilot, operation and support



- The Platform has been operating since mid-September 2023, having:
 - a) Space for discussion and exchange of views
 (for registered users personal data protection professionals)
 - b) Digital Library with supporting material (open to all)
- HDPA to <u>support</u> and <u>operate</u> the platform even after the end of the project (end of August 2024)
 - According to the proposal and the Grant Agreement



Use of the platform: Discussion space



- 342 (313 on July 1st) users
- 23 forums 220 Topics 272 Posts










Users Evaluation Feedback (1)



- Questionnaire compiled and sent to the Platform users, referring to the:
 - 1. Willingness to use the Platform
 - 2. Platform complexity
 - 3. Ease of use
 - 4. Technical competencies implied
 - 5. Thoroughness
 - 6. Uniformity
 - 7. Anticipated field reach
 - 8. Platform Complexity
 - 9. User Confidence
 - 10. Prerequisites of its use






Users Evaluation Feedback (2)



- Also, referring to user's:
 - 1. Discussion space visit rate (Reason for low)
 - 2. Posts made Experience
 - 3. Posts replied Experience Information acquired?
 - 4. Digital library use rate (Reason for low)





Platform evaluation results



- Based on 42 users' feedback on the targeted questionnaire
- The technical implementation
 - particularly positive evaluation
 - simple and easy to use, uncomplicated, with sufficiently comprehensive functions
- Users recognize that they are not making enough use of the platform
- Users cite lack of time as the main reason for underutilizing the platform and digital library
 - not needed in their professional daily life
 - easy to find information in another way
- Nevertheless, they state that they would like it to be enriched with more thematic sections.



Output



- Given that the Platform has low participation, is it useful to retain it, to modify it or should it be replaced by another solution?
 - a) it is useful as it is (45%)
 - b) it should be enriched with other functions (31%)
 - c) It should have been implemented differently (~25%)
- It should be promoted more by the Authority
 - individual comments' dominant view



Internal understanding



- Limited number of field professionals that are constantly and actively engaged in the field
- Part-time occupation leads to lack of resources allocation/utilization
- Minimum engagement of moderators
- DPOs' participation at a low level
 - Unexpressed unwillingness to expose Controller/Processor(employer) or even DPO shortcomings
 - Limited training/awareness
- HDPA need to promote the tool as the standard & 'authorized' means of feedback amongst the relevant stakeholders







- Platform promotion
 in the HDPA website as the <u>primary means</u> of field guidance
- Platform establishment
 as the basic means of communication/interaction amongst DPOs
- Debate
 - requirements analysis via international engagement
- Moderators review
